Matthew 10:26-33

The Lord's Day Morning

"Hell is a place of eternal conscious punishment for the wicked." – Wayne Grudem

## The Two Reasons Why We Do Anything

1. Positive: To enjoy pleasure and/or help others enjoy pleasure.
2. Negative: To escape pain and/ or help others escape pain.

## Seven Things Every Student Needs to Know (Review from Friday Night)

1. What you *should* fear the most but probably don't: Final judgment (Matthew 10:28)
2. All of us deserve hell. (Romans 3:23; 6:8; James 2:10)
3. Most people (119/120 or 99.2%) do not fear hell.
4. Most people will get what they deserve (justice), but a few will get mercy (Matt. 7:14-15).
5. There is only one way to get mercy (John 3:16; John 14:6).
6. This is the most important decision you will ever make (Luke 9:25; Luke 12:20).
7. You don't have much time to make it (Luke 12:20).

## Seven Reasons To Believe In Hell

1. \_\_\_\_\_ believed in hell.  
*Mt 5:22 ...But anyone who says, 'You fool!' will be in danger of the fire of hell.*
2. \_\_\_\_\_ believed in hell.  
*2 Thess. 1: 7. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. 8 He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power.*
3. \_\_\_\_\_ of the Christian church has believed in hell.  
*"[At] the consummation of the world Christ will appear for judgment, and will raise up all the dead; He will give to the godly and elect eternal life and everlasting joys, but ungodly men and the devils He will condemn to be tormented without end. (Augsburg Confession, Lutheran Book of Concord, 1530, Article 17)*
4. Hell is consistent with the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.  
*Isa 16:5 In love a throne will be established; in faithfulness a man will sit on it--one from the house of David--one who in judging seeks justice and speeds the cause of righteousness.*
5. Hell is consistent with the \_\_\_\_\_ of man.  
*1 John 5: 12 He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.*
6. The heinousness of an offense rises in proportion to the \_\_\_\_\_ of the one offended.  
*Hab 1:13 Your eyes are too pure to look on evil; you cannot tolerate wrong.*
7. The heinousness of an offense rises in proportion to your \_\_\_\_\_ to the one offended.  
*Isaiah 6:5 "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty."*
