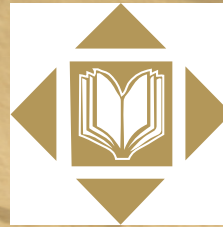

What are Adult Bible Fellowships?

Adult Bible Fellowships (ABFs) are groups of adults who meet together for fellowship around the solid teaching of Scripture. These groups provide a healthy environment for developing relationships within a larger church. In effect, each ABF is a small congregation-within-a-congregation made up of members who are committed to care for one another and reach out to those who are not yet connected to biblical community.

When and where do Adult Bible Fellowships meet?
